



## COVID-19 Weekly Case Counts

The School District of Pickens County is keeping track of the number of students and staff who have been quarantined due to close contact and/or tested positive for COVID-19. Note that our counts include staff members or students whose contact with COVID-19 occurred outside of school or before school began. Parents are notified if and when a COVID-19 positive individual has been present within their child's school, within their child's classroom, or within close contact with their child.
